Exhibit Space and Display Standards

Use of Space

Exhibitor standard for displays and signage must adhere to Licensor's written guidelines and must be approved by Licensor on acceptance of application. Each exhibitor shall be restricted to showing only those goods described in this agreement, and shall confine its exhibit, activities and operations to the licensed space. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Exhibitor shall be prohibited from handing out coupons, samples or other materials belonging to or promoting the wares or activities of third parties and shall strictly confine all permitted activities to the licensed space. In addition, use of the space shall be strictly restricted to the Exhibitor and the Exhibitor shall not assign, either in part or in whole, otherwise permit the participation of any third party in any of the activities, undertakings or displays in the licensed space, without the prior express written consent of the Licensor. In the event of the failure of the Exhibitor to utilize all its space to the satisfaction of the Licensor, the Licensor may at any time after the opening hour of the Show allot any vacant space to such other applicant, as it may deem appropriate, in its sole discretion, for the benefit of the exhibition. The Licensor reserves the right to relocate contracted exhibit space as it may deem necessary, in its sole discretion, for the overall benefit of the exhibition. The use of said space shall be subject to the Rules and Regulations appearing in this contract and in the "Exhibitor Manual" and to all further rules and regulations now or hereafter adopted for the conduct of said Show, which are hereby, made a part of this Agreement and to which the Exhibitor agrees strictly to conform. The Exhibitor further acknowledges that the Licensor is a party to an occupancy agreement pursuant to which the use and occupation of the building by the Licensor and all Exhibitors is governed. The Exhibitor agrees to be bound by the terms, conditions, rules and regulations set forth in such agreement.

Character of Exhibits

The Licensor reserves the right, without compensation to the Exhibitor, in its sole discretion, to decline, prohibit or remove any exhibit, Exhibitor or proposed exhibit or Exhibitor not approved of by it, and to permit only such matter and conduct as it shall approve. The above reservation covers persons, things, conduct, printed matter, souvenirs and emblems, and all things which effect the character of the exhibition and the Exhibitor will not obstruct or hinder the Licensor in preventing or removing forthwith any matter, conduct or thing which it considers objectionable.

Risks

All property used or exhibited is at the sole risk of the Exhibitor, and the Licensor will not assume any responsibility for the safety of exhibits against theft, robbery, fire, accidents or for any matter or thing whatsoever, or for bodily injury or damage to property or persons caused by the operations of the Exhibitor. The Exhibitor understands and agrees that the Licensor shall assume no responsibility for representations or warranties given by the Exhibitor to the public in regard to its products or services or for transactions or contracts between the Exhibitor and the public, or for any losses or damages arising there from.

Insurance

All Exhibitors must have General Commercial Liability insurance of a minimum of two million dollars prior to the show. The Exhibitor shall add the Licensor (8061246 Canada Inc.) as an additional insured and hold the Licensor harmless from any damage, expense or liability, to or in respect to any person, arising out of the Exhibitor's occupancy of the said licensed space or anything or matter connected with such occupancy or the activities of the Exhibitor, its servants, agents or employees in conjunction therewith, whether or not such activities shall occur in the licensed space, the building or elsewhere. **All exhibitors must provide the Licensor with proof of insurance 30 days prior to the show.**

Removal of Goods

Under no circumstances shall any portion of an exhibit be removed from the licensed space during the continuance of the Show without prior written permission of the Licensor. The Exhibitor will cause all exhibits, equipment and products to be removed from the Show premises on the date and time specified as "Exhibit Removal Deadline" in the Exhibitor Manual. The Licensor shall be entitled to remove all exhibits, equipment and products of the Exhibitor to any place of storage, and the Exhibitor shall be liable for all additional charges or damages incurred by the Licensor for or by reason of all such property of the Exhibitor left on the Show premises or other environs after such deadline.

Prevention or Interruption of Use of Premises

The Licensor reserves the right, exercisable in its sole discretion, to change the date or dates upon which the Show is to be held and shall not be liable in damages or otherwise by reason of such change. In the event the Show is cancelled because of reasons beyond the control of the Licensor, space rental fees or deposits already made will be returned to Exhibitors on a pro rata basis, after all related expenses incurred by the licensor through the date of cancellation have been met, and the Licensor shall be released from any and all claims for damage which might arise in consequence thereof.

Labour Agreements

The Exhibitor agrees to observe all union contracts and labour relation agreements in force, agreements between the Licensor, official contractor service companies and the building in which the Show will take place and the labour laws of the jurisdiction in which the building is located.

Cancellation Policy

No amount paid or payable by the Exhibitor hereunder is refundable in the event the Exhibitor does not use the reserved space. The Licensor shall have full power in the interpretation and enforcement of all Rules and Regulations whether contained herein or otherwise and the power to make such amendments thereto and such further rules and regulations governing participation in the Show as it shall consider necessary for the proper conduct of said Show. If the Exhibitor fails to make any said payments at the time appointed thereof, all rights of the Exhibitor hereunder shall cease and terminate, and any payments made by it on account hereof prior to said time may be retained by the Licensor as liquidated damages for the breach of this Agreement, and the Licensor may thereupon re-license said space. The Licensor may at any time that the Exhibitor fails to pay any indebtedness owed by the Exhibitor to Licensor, after demand, seize and sell any property of the Exhibitor within the Show premises or their environs, either at public auction or by private sale, and may apply the proceeds thereof against such indebtedness, together with its costs, without prejudice to any other rights of the Licensor, and the Exhibitor shall be liable for any deficiency or loss suffered by the Licensor. This license may be terminated by the Licensor at any time on the breach of any of the terms or conditions hereof by the Exhibitor, and thereupon all rights of the Exhibitor hereunder shall cease and terminate, and any payments made by it on account hereof to said termination shall be retained by the Licensor as liquidated damages for such breach, and the Licensor may thereupon re-license said space. Until this application is accepted by the Licensor, the exhibitor shall be entitled to the return of the rent paid, upon notice in writing to the licensor.

General

In the event that any provision of these terms, conditions and rules shall be found to be illegal or otherwise unenforceable, the balance of these terms, conditions or rules shall remain in full force and effect. No waiver or permitted variation of any provision hereof shall be taken to permit any future waiver or variation of such provision. The Exhibitor hereby consents to the use of any pictures or other images by the Licensor in the subsequent promotion of this Show or any other show of the Licensor. There is no representation, warranty or condition made by binding upon the Licensor affecting the subject matter of this Agreement of the said space other than as expressed herein or in the Exhibitor Manual or in writing signed by the Licensor. Nothing herein shall be construed as constituting the Exhibitor and the Licensor partners, joint ventures or agents of one another. The Exhibitor has read and understands the Rules and Regulations and understands that this application and the contract resulting from it will be subject to these Rules and Regulations. The Licensor reserves the right to determine the eligibility and appropriateness of exhibits before acceptance of this contract. This contract and any disputes that may arise therefrom shall be interpreted and governed in accordance with laws of Ontario. The parties hereby irrevocably attorn to the jurisdiction of the Courts of the Province of Ontario, it being the intention of the parties that all disputes shall be settled by the Courts of the Province of Ontario applying the laws of the Province of Ontario.

Compliance with Health & Safety Law

Exhibitors, their on-site staff and suppliers/contractors, shall comply with all show terms, rules and regulations, and with all pertinent and applicable laws, codes and regulations, Federal, Provincial, Municipal and local, including any Occupational Health & Safety legislation, which may affect the show space. It is also the sole responsibility of the Exhibitor to ensure that all their on-site staff and suppliers/contractors are informed of and comply with all these terms at all times while on the show property. The exhibitor agrees to be liable for the actions of its on-site staff and suppliers/contractors. These terms and regulations will be enforced by both Licensor and the appropriate municipal, provincial and federal regulator. Exhibitor's failure to comply with such laws, terms, rules and regulations shall entitle the Licensor to terminate Licensor's obligations under this contract and remove, shut down or darken Exhibitor's space. The Licensor's decision on all such matters shall be final. The Exhibitor accepts full responsibility for its legal liability and any losses or fines incurred as a result of failure to comply with health and safety laws. If the Licensor should be held liable for an exhibitor's action or failure to comply with its legal obligations, the exhibitor shall reimburse the Licensor for all expenses incurred and hold the Licensor harmless for any resulting liability.

Fire & Electrical Safety

Exhibitors must comply with all facility and local Fire Code Regulations. Booth decorations must be flameproof and all hangings must clear the floor. Electrical wiring must conform with all National, Provincial and Municipal government requirements and to the local provincial Electrical Code Safety Rules. If inspection indicates that an exhibitor has neglected to comply with these terms, or otherwise incurs a fire or electrical hazard, the Licensor reserves the right to cancel all or such part of the exhibit as may be out of compliance.

Injury, Loss, or Damage

The Licensor will not be responsible for any injury, loss or damage that may occur to or be caused by the exhibitor to the exhibitor's employees, property, or to the facility from any cause whatsoever. The Licensor will not be held liable for any injury, loss, or damage which is sustained by any person who may be on the premises leased or rented to the exhibitor, or watching, observing, or participating in any demonstration in the exhibitor's exhibit unless such injury, loss, or damage is caused by active negligence or a willful act of the Licensor. If the Licensor should be held liable for an exhibitor's action or failure to act in any manner whatsoever, the exhibitor shall reimburse Licensor for all expenses incurred and hold the Licensor harmless for any resulting liability.

Exhibit Space and Display Standards

Exhibitors in all motorcycle shows owned by the Licensor must comply with the following guidelines. A complete explanation of the following items is detailed in the official show Exhibitor Manual. Please read and sign to acknowledge acceptance of these standards.

These are new product, public showcase shows. Non-current, but unsold new inventory is acceptable. **No used equipment may be sold.**

1. Display areas must have carpet or other appropriate floor covering throughout. Only approved double sided tape to be used.
2. NO CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 14 are permitted on the show floor during Move-In (up until 12 noon on Friday) and Move-Out (starting Sunday at 5pm). In accordance with Provincial Regulations-all children will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
3. Professional signs are required - no hand-written or 'home-made' signs. All signs must be made of firm material that does not sag or provision must be made to post the sign properly. Use of duct tape or related materials may not be used to hang signs or used on support mechanisms. Signage must not exceed the backdrop height restriction of 8 feet. If required, the Licensor has final word on placement and suitability of any sign.
4. Insurance: Exhibitors and Non-profit clubs or associations must provide the Licensor with proof of exhibitor's insurance in the amount and type specified in the Insurance provision of the Exhibitor Space and Display Standards prior to the show.
5. Professional-looking displays are required. Cardboard/storage boxes used for non-merchandised inventory must be out of sight and not used as display materials. Custom built displays are encouraged. It is up to the exhibitor to ensure all display material conforms to regulations posted in the exhibitor manual.
6. 'Pop-Up' Tents are not allowed due to Fire Regulations unless pre-approved by the Licensor and the fire inspector for the Show.
7. Exhibitors are not permitted to promote Night Clubs or Adult Clubs or use any staff or volunteers from those Clubs in their exhibit to promote their exhibit.
8. Dress Code is 'Business Casual' or attire reflective of the product or service the general public may purchase from your company. Dress should at all times reflect the family atmosphere. Proper personal grooming of all your staff should be assumed and includes clean attire and generally courteous public demeanor at all times.
9. Retail exhibitors are not to sell or display inappropriate clothing or products. (i.e. slang, slurs, racist, sexist or offensive language, products for drug use, explicit videos or videos condoning and promoting improper riding). The Licensor reserves the right without compensation to the Exhibitor to prohibit or remove any product which, in the Licensor's opinion, does not conform to the show's Exhibit Space and Display Standards.
10. Use of space by exhibitors should not infringe on aisles. This includes areas for trying on clothes or viewing areas for video presentations. Sound levels must be monitored to be respectful of your neighbours.
11. All retail exhibitors must provide documents stating the services/warranty of the products or services they offer for sale at the show with a copy of their return/refund policy. Exhibitors must provide receipts. Charities must provide receipts for all donations.
12. All exhibitors must supply an exhibit description that includes all products, draws, etc. that will be in the booth to Licensor before an application is approved and a contract is issued. Non-profit clubs & associations must comply with all standards i.e.: professional signs, full coverage carpeting, etc.
13. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be aware of show hours. Displays and products must remain in full service up to closing. Early break down/move out is not permitted. The Licensor will charge a penalty and/or withhold display space for subsequent shows.
14. Fire regulations strictly prohibit starting the engine of any motorized vehicle, motorcycle, ATV, or product during show hours. All engines must be displayed according to fire regulations as stated in the Exhibitor Manual.
15. The Licensor reserves the right to enforce the above Exhibit Space and Display Standards. Please Note - any exhibitor not complying with any of the above standards may be required to leave the show floor and future exhibiting will be at risk NO EXCEPTIONS.
16. Staff of an authorized motorcycle and power sport dealer(s) shall not conduct or attempt to conduct sales within the confines of the OEM booth. Discussions related to a sale of product may take place within the show in their own dealer booth or in the lounge/restaurant area or in some other discrete area.
17. All on-road vehicles displayed in the show for retail sale, must be Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (CMVSS) certified.

Occupational Health and Safety Acknowledgement Important Notice to all Exhibitors

Dear Valued Exhibitor:

The Motorcycle Show, Montreal requires that all exhibitors review, sign and return the attached form to acknowledge their acceptance and understanding of its contents.

The Ministry of Labour has declared that all show sites are deemed "construction sites" which requires that all persons involved in the set up and tear down of a show be appropriately equipped for such an environment. Consequently, the provisions of the Occupational Health and Safety Legislation and its Regulations (particularly the Regulations Dealing with Construction Projects) are applicable to all shows including The Motorcycle Show, Montreal.

The Motorcycle Show, Montreal requires that all exhibitors adhere to the highest standards of safety when setting up and tearing down an exhibit and take every reasonable precaution to protect the health and safety of workers. It is required that all exhibitors of The Motorcycle Show, Montreal respect and comply with the Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations and ensure the following:

- That all workers involved in the set up and tear down of the show are competent to perform their assigned duties.
- That the workers will be provided with information, instruction, training and supervision to protect the health and safety of the worker and that every precaution reasonable for the circumstances is taken to protect the worker.
- Where prescribed, safety equipment, materials and protective devices are provided and that such equipment, materials and protective devices are in good condition. This includes safety shoes, gloves, safety glasses and hard hats.
- That the equipment, materials and protective devices provided are used as prescribed.
- That a copy of the Occupational Health and Safety Act and any explanatory material prepared by the Ministry of Labour which outline the rights, responsibilities and duties of workers are posted on the premises.
- Under the Health and Safety Act it is the duty of every exhibitor to ensure that it, in the circumstances specific to the exhibitor's participation in the Show, every reasonable precaution has been taken to protect the health and safety of its workers and any other person who works on the set up, operation and tear down of the exhibit or attends thereon. Exhibitors will be held accountable, at all times, for the health and safety of those working for them on the show floor.
- NO CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 14 are permitted on the show floor during Move-In (up until 12 noon on Friday) and Move-Out (starting Sunday at 5 pm). In accordance with Provincial Regulations, all children will be asked to leave the premises immediately.

Health and Safety Acknowledgement Form

I, the undersigned, acknowledge that I have read and understood the health and safety acknowledgement. Further, I agree to indemnify and save harmless the Licensor (i.e. 8061246 Canada Inc., o/a Power Sport Services) and its employees and contracted staff and businesses from all claims, demands, actions, or causes of action and against any liability for damages, losses, expenses, fines and penalties of whatever kind or nature, arising out of any accidents or mishaps which may occur before, during or after the show which may be attributable to exhibitor negligence or breach of the Occupational Health and Safety Act and its Regulations in setting up or tearing down the exhibit, including limiting the generality of the foregoing, any fines or penalties assessed against the Indemnified under the Occupational Health and Safety Act.

In the event that the Indemnified Parties become involved in a charge, prosecution, civil litigation or any other legal proceeding under or related to the Occupational Health and Safety Act and its regulations arising out of or related to a breach of the contract or my performance or lack of performance of the contract or the violation of the Occupational Health and Safety Act and its Regulations, then, as an Exhibitor, I agree to be liable for, indemnify and pay the Indemnified parties' fine, penalty, judgment, debt, damages and reasonable legal fees.

I understand and acknowledge that 8061246 Canada Inc. O/A Power Sport Services (PSS) will need to share my or my company's email address or other information with specific and contracted show suppliers as a condition of exhibiting in the show.
